## MICROSOFT AZURE ADMINISTRATOR TRAINING

### Required exam – AZ:104 (Microsoft Azure Administrator )

The AZ-104 exam replaces the AZ-103 exam, which will be retired on August 31, 2020. This exam is part of Microsoft's role-based certification program. Candidates who pass the AZ-104 exam will earn the Microsoft Certified: Azure Administrator Associate certification. This exam measures your ability to accomplish the following technical tasks: manage Azure identities and governance; implement and manage storage; deploy and manage Azure compute resources; configure and manage virtual networking; and monitor and back up Azure resources. Candidates for this exam should have subject matter expertise implementing, managing, and monitoring an organization's Microsoft Azure environment.

### TARGET AUDIENCE



- ▶ IT Engineers who aims to become Azure administrators
- ▶ Candidates preparing for Microsoft's AZ-104 exam
- ▶ IT professionals who works for organizations that are planning to locate some or all of their infrastructure services on Azure
